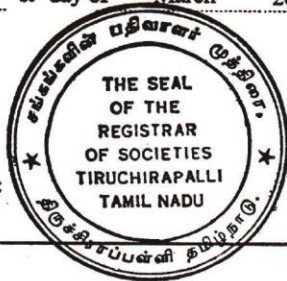

With reference to the letter cited above, the Secretary of National College Council has submitted an application seeking prior permission under section 30 (2) of the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 1975 for trifurcation of the said society by the name and style as follows:

1. National College Council (Parent body)
2. Saranathan Academy of Higher Education (to be registered)
3. Academy of Higher Education (to be registered)

In support of the application, he has also presented a Special Resolution in connection with the trifurcation passed in the Extra ordinary General Body Meeting specially convened on 30.08.03. He has stated the following reasons for the trifurcation:

- 1) With a view to ensure efficient administration with greater focus on the units.
- 2) To separate aided and unaided institutions as far as possible.

Examining the application, the above said Special Resolution and the reasons set forth in the application, the Registrar of Societies having satisfied with the above factors, do hereby approve the above trifurcation of the National College Council under section 30 (2) of the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 1975.

It is informed that as per section 30 (3) of the Societies Registration Act 1975 the division shall have no effect until and unless two new societies to be registered as per Special Resolution are duly registered in accordance with the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 1975.



2. **Objects:**

THE OBJECTS OF THE SOCIETY ARE:

- a) To efficiently manage, and administer the NATIONAL COLLEGE, Tiruchirappalli-1 and SESA IYENGAR MEMORIAL HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL, Woriyur, Tiruchirappalli-3 and other Educational Institutions under the Management of this Society and establish or amalgamate or associate with other Educational Institutions or activities and manage and administer them and give financial assistance and donations to any other Educational Institutions or Activity for public good and to foster National Education.
- b) To do such other acts and things as may be calculated to achieve the above objects.





BYE-LAWS OF THE SOCIETY.

1. The name of the Society shall be "DR. V. KRISHNAMURTHY EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION"
2. The address of the Registered Office of the Society is at National College, Dindigul Road, Tiruchirappalli-1.
3. The National College Council registered as No 3 of 1909 , Trichy was trifurcated under Section 30 of the Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act 1975 allotting specific members and area of operation to this new Society by special resolution dated 30th August 2003, with the due approval of the Registrar and to come into operation on the Registration of the new Societies under Section 30 (3) and (4) of the Act and in pursuance of which this Memorandum is duly signed on this day the First Day of March, 2004.
4. This Society is within the jurisdiction of the Registrar of Societies, Tiruchirappalli.
5. The business hours of the Society shall be between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. on all working days except Sundays and Government Holidays.
6. The objects of the Society are those as mentioned in the Memorandum of the Association and in particular, the following:
 - a) To efficiently manage, and administer the NATIONAL COLLEGE, Tiruchirappalli-1 and SETHA IYENGAR MEMORIAL HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL, Woriyur, Tiruchirappalli-3 and other Educational Institutions under the Management of this Society and establish or amalgamate or associate with other Educational Institutions or activities and manage and administer them and give financial assistance and donations to any other Educational Institutions or Activity for public good and to foster National Education.
 - b To do such other acts and things as may be calculated to achieve the above objects.

7. The activities of the Society shall include all kinds of activities necessary for the attainment of its objectives as stated above and in particular developing the Educational Institutions and their activities under its management and engage in other activities as may be decided by the managing committee from time to time to fulfil the objects of the Society.
8. The Secretary of the Society shall be the person authorised to sue and be sued on behalf of the Society.
9. The Secretary shall be the person who is empowered to give directions on behalf of the Society.
- 10.A The General Body of the Society shall consist of persons who are members of the Society as on 21st May 2011 and the persons admitted as members in future as envisaged in clause B hereunder.
- 10.B "Individuals who each pay a donation of not less than Rs.3,00,000/- to the corpus fund of the society and agrees to execute personal guarantee and / or stand as surety for the borrowings, if any made by the Society from any bank or financial institution, as and when required by such bank or financial institution and admitted as members by the executive committee at its discretion. Any existing member can migrate themselves to be a member under this clause after fulfilling both the above conditions i.e. a donation of not less than Rs.3,00,000/- to the corpus fund of the Society and agreeing to execute personal guarantee and / or surety as stated above, within a period of 90 days from 21st May 2011. Any individual who is admitted as a member under this clause, if disqualified for any reason from standing as a guarantor and / or as a surety or refusing to execute necessary documents in connection with the guarantee / surety at a later date to a bank or financial institution, he / she shall cease to be a member of the Society with immediate effect and incase such a person has migrated to be a member under this clause, he shall be reverted back to be a member under clause 10A above as existed prior to 21.05.2011".
11. If the executive committee for any reason considers the cotinuanance of any member of the Society as a Member is injurious to the interest of the Society or its reputation or if any member becomes incapable of continuing as member for any reason, the Executive Committee is empowered to remove the member from the membership. Any member so removed from the membership of this Society by the Executive Committee may appeal to the General Body against the decision of the Executive Committee and the decision of the General Body shall become final.

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12. The rights, obligations and privileges of members shall be as provided in the Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act and Law. The Members are entitled to attend the General Body Meeting and exercise his vote.
13. The Powers and Functions of the General Body of the Society shall be.
 - a) To consider and adopt the annual reports of the Society's work and the audited statement of accounts.
 - b) To discuss and pass the Budget for the year.
 - c) To elect the Members to the Executive Committee.
 - d) To elect the Office bearers of the Society viz the President , Vice President Secretary and Joint Secretary.
 - e) To appoint an Auditor, who shall be a Chartered Accountant and to fix his remuneration.
 - f) To add, alter or amend these regulations (Name , Objects and Bylaws) at a duly convened General Body Meeting by a Special Resolution following the procedures prescribed for passing a Special Resolution.
 - g) This Society may be divided or amalgamated with another society as per the provisions of the Section 30 of the Act by a Special Resolution as provided in the Act.
 - h) And to lay down the general policy of the Society from time to time.

MANAGING COMMITTEE/ EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

14. "The affairs of the Society shall be managed by an "Executive Committee" consisting of NINE members, out of which atleast SIX shall be persons admitted as members under clause 10B above. However, in case there are no SIX members under clause 10B or not willing to accept the appointment of member of the Executive Committee, then such shortfall shall be filled in by any member of the Society. However, the existing Executive Committee as on 21st May 2011 shall continue to function till the expiry of its term".
15. a) All members of the Executive Committee shall be elected at a Meeting of the General Body once in three years. The first Committee which comes into being from the date of registration of the Society, shall hold Office for a period of three years.
- b) "The PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, SECRETARY, JOINT SECRETARY shall be elected from the Members of the Executive Committee by the General Body to hold Office for a period of three years, of which the PRESIDENT and SECRETARY shall be persons who are members under Clause 10B. However, the existing Office bearers of the Executive Committee as on 21st May 2011 shall continue to function till the expiry of its term".
- c) The Executive Committee shall have power to fill up casual vacancies in the Committee by co-option. Persons co-opted shall be members of the Committee till the date on which the original Member would vacate Office.
- d) The Executive Committee shall have power to fill up casual vacancies in the post of President or Vice President or Secretary or Joint Secretary by electing one member of the Executive Committee for the Post. Persons so elected shall hold Office till the date on which the original Member would vacate Office.

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MEETING OF THE GENERAL BODY:

- 16.a) The General Body of the Society shall meet as often as may be necessary in the opinion of the Executive Committee or of the President. At least one General Meeting of the Registered Society shall be held in every financial year within six months from the end of the financial year.
- b) Notice of Twenty one clear days shall be given of any meeting of the General Body to all Members of the Society.
- c) The Notice of General Body meeting to members may be sent
1. by local delivery or
 2. by post or
 3. by circulation among members or
 4. by publication through press
- The notice shall also be affixed to the notice board of the Society.
- d) The Secretary shall be the person to convene the General Body Meeting
17. An Extraordinary General Meeting shall be called when twenty percent of the members of the General Body deposit a requisition with the President or the Secretary giving in detail the subjects to be transacted and such meeting shall be convened within THIRTY days of the deposit of the requisition.

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18. The President or in his absence, the Vice-President and in the absence of both of them, one of the members duly elected at the meeting shall take the chair and conduct the Meeting.
19. Twenty percent of the total number of Members of the Society personally present in any Meeting of the General Body shall be the quorum. Where the quorum is not present within 30 minutes of the time scheduled for the commencement of the meeting, the meeting (except the meeting convened at the requisition of members) may be cancelled at the discretion of the Secretary. The meeting without quorum shall in case of a meeting convened at the requisition of the members and may in other cases at the discretion of the Secretary be adjourned to the same day in the next week at the same time and at the same place. The adjourned meeting shall have power to transact all businesses on the agenda. The Members present shall form the quorum and the business transacted during such adjourned meeting shall be binding on all. No fresh notice to the members of the adjourned meeting is necessary.
20. Ordinary Resolutions shall be passed by majority of the persons inclusive of the President present at the Meeting and Voting and in case of equal division the President shall have another casting vote.
21. A Special Resolutions shall be passed by a Seventy Five percent majority of the members present at the meeting.

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MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

22. The Executive Committee of the Society shall meet as often as may be necessary provided that not more than 3 months shall lapse since the date of the preceding meeting.
23. The Meeting shall be presided over by the President or the Vice-President in the absence of the President, or by any other member of the Committee duly chosen in the absence of the President and Vice-President.
24. THREE days' clear Notice shall be given of any Meeting of the Executive Committee to the persons entitled thereto.
25. FIFTY PERCENT of the total number of the Members of the Executive Committee shall form the quorum for any meeting of the Executive Committee.
26. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The Executive Committee shall have, inter-alia, the following powers and functions:

- a) To appoint such staff as may be necessary from time to time for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Society and to punish or remove them in accordance with law, and such powers may be delegated to such person or body as it deems fit.

- b) To admit any person subscribing to the objects of the Society as Member as per bylaw 10 (b) of the Memorandum.
- c) To appoint Sub-committees as may be considered necessary from time to time and invest such Sub-committees with necessary powers and functions.
- d) To examine and check the accounts periodically.
- e) To invest funds and monies of the Society in such manner as may be deemed expedient and in accordance with the provisions of law.
- f) To open and operate Bank accounts of any type, pattern or nature, in the name of the Society from time to time with Bank or Banks as may be considered necessary. All such accounts shall be operated by the Secretary individually
- g) To call for meetings of the Members of the Society as and when necessary.
- h) To institute, conduct or defend, compound, compromise, refer to arbitration or abandon any legal or other proceedings, claims and disputes in the name of the Society and to engage any attorney, advocate or Legal Practitioner in this regard provided however that the Secretary shall be the person entitled to sue and be sued on behalf of the Society.
- i) To delegate such of its powers and functions as may be considered necessary from time to time to any one or more of the Office bearers of the Society.

- j) And generally exercise all powers necessary to carry out the objects of the Society except those which are exercisable only by the members of the Society in General Body meetings of the members by virtue of these regulations and by virtue of the provisions of law.
- k) To make donations to other Educational Institutions, Activity for public good and for the cause of Education .
- 27.a The PRESIDENT and in his absence the Vice President and in the absence of both of them one of the members duly elected at the meeting shall take the chair and conduct the Meeting of Managing Committee.
- b) The president may delegate any or all of his powers from time to time to the Vice-President.
28. The VICE PRESIDENT shall discharge such duties as may be delegated to him by the President . During the absence of the President, the Vice President shall discharge the functions of the President.

29. SECRETARY- The duties of the Secretary shall be :

- a) Convening in consultation with the President, Meetings of the General Body and of the Managing Committee and issuing notices and Agenda therefor ;
- b) Recording the minutes of the Meetings of the Committee and of the General Body in the Books;
- c) Maintain list of members and other books and registers prescribed by or under the Act.
- d) To issue receipts for all subscriptions, donations, benefactions, grants and other sums received and obtain vouchers for all payments made.
- e) To cause regular accounts to be maintained recording all transactions contemporaneously in the books of accounts. Such accounts shall be placed periodically before the Executive Committee.
- f) The Secretary shall prepare and file with the concerned Registrar annual and other statements as contemplated in the act and rule.

- g) To Carry out such other functions as may be entrusted to him by the Executive Committee or the members in General Body Meeting from time to time.
 - h) The Secretary or any other member of the Managing Committee duly empowered in writing by the Secretary shall be the person empowered to give directions with regard to day to day affairs of the Society.
 - i) The Secretary if necessary may delegate his powers in writing to any other member of the managing committee to act and function on his behalf.
30. The Joint Secretary shall associate himself with the Secretary and enable him to efficiently discharge his duties . He shall individually exercise such powers and discharge such duties and function of the Secretary that may be delegated to him by the Secretary.

31. AUDIT AND ACCOUNTS

- a) The accounting year of the Society shall be from 1st April of every year and ending with 31st March of the succeeding year.
- b) Regular accounts shall be maintained regarding all transactions entering them contemporaneously in the books of accounts and be placed periodically at the Executive Meeting.

- c) Proper books of accounts shall be kept and at the expiration of each financial year a receipt and expenditure of accounts and the balance sheet be prepared and it shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the General Body. The auditor shall have access to all books of accounts and records.
- d) The statement of accounts showing the receipts and payments made during the year and of income and expenditure made in respect of the year shall, with a statement of assets and liabilities, duly audited be placed before the executive committee, with the Auditor's Report. The audited annual accounts and the Auditor's Report thereon shall be placed before the Annual General Meeting of the Members before the 30th day of September of the succeeding year.
- e) The bye-laws of the Society, and the audited statement of annual income and expenditure and assets and liabilities shall be supplied to the members free of cost on request.
32. All property movable and immovable belonging to the Society shall vest with the Executive Committee.
33. The register of members, the books containing minutes and the books of accounts shall be available at the registered office of the Society during the business hours for inspection by the members of the Society free of charge on request.

34. **CEASATION OF MEMBERSHIP OF THE SOCIETY**

"If any member of the Society is absent continuously for three General Body Meetings (whether Annual General Body or otherwise) of the Society without leave of absence with specific reason for being absent, he / she shall cease to be a member of the Society with immediate effect.

35. **BORROWING POWERS**

"The Executive Committee may from time to time, borrow from any banks or financial institutions any sum or sums of money, not exceeding Rs.35,00,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Crores Only) for the purpose of achieving the objectives of the Society, as the Executive Committee may think fit and proper. The Executive Committee to secure the repayment of such money may mortgage and / or create charge on all or any of the assets and / or properties of the Society including the immovable properties of the Society, in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as the Executive Committee may think fit and proper. The Executive Committee may authorise the Secretary to execute all deeds, documents, applications etc., required in connection with the creation of such mortgage or charge".







36. **DISSOLUTION.**

In the event of dissolution of the Society being decided upon by a Special Resolution of the General Body, the Society shall be dissolved and in such contingency all assets shall be transferred to or donated to any other Society with similar objects, as per Section 41 of the Act.

37. In respect of matters not specifically provided for in this bye-laws, the provisions of the Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act 1975 and Rules shall apply.




